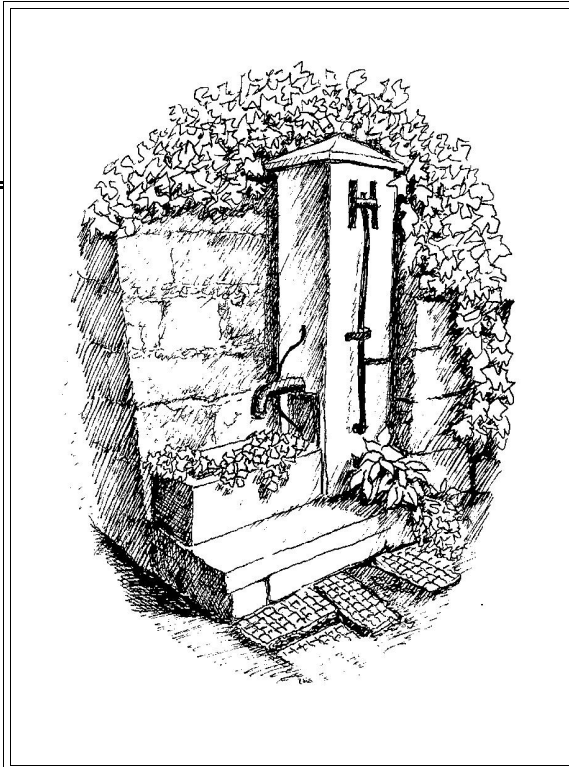

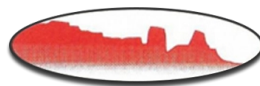


### Kirkby & Gt. Broughton Nursery
